



How do I make my article Open Access ?

My paper was published in an open access journal, or I paid for direct open access.

My paper was not, or will not be published in an open access journal, nor did I pay for direct open access.

Publisher's version
no embargo needed

Go to Pure (<https://pure.uva.nl/admin>) in which the tool Sherpa RoMEO is integrated, or go directly to Sherpa RoMEO (<http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo>). It is important to take publishing policies into consideration. If the journal is listed, please note:
- The colour of the journal's archiving policy.
- Embargo required?
- If so: how long? The set copyright statement (if required by the publisher).

My paper has been accepted for publication but has not yet been published.

*** Description of the article version you can archive:**
Pre-print Manuscript version of article, as sent to journal for consideration (i.e. pre-refereeing).
Post-print Version accepted by journal, but does not yet contain journal layout (i.e. final draft post-refereeing).
Publisher's Final published version.

Check the copyright agreement you signed (or the standard copyright agreement on the journal's website) for:

- any restrictions on which version* you are allowed to post;
- any embargo you might need to apply; and
- is a set copyright statement required on a pre- or post-print*?

In Pure a pre-print is in Pure a 'Submitted manuscript' ; and a postprint an 'Accepted author manuscript' (= 'Document version')

Upload the file in Pure as 'Open'.

If the journal requires an embargo on the article, upload the file in Pure as 'Embargoed' (please enter the date on which the embargo expires).

The file will become available in UvA-DARE (if an embargo applies, on the day the embargo expires).
