
Study spaces

All library locations offer a variety of study spaces: individual spaces, collaborative spaces, study rooms and classrooms. Some study spaces are equipped with a desktop PC and/or a large monitor. There are also spaces suitable for video calls.

Collaborative workspaces and study booths can be reserved in advance with vour UvAnetID.

spaces are available. Library locations are only accessible to UvA students upon presentation of a valid student ID card.



Kanopy is a video streaming platform that provides access to documentaries, films and TV shows.

Borrowing

If you want to borrow any books or printed materials you find at the Library, you can take them from the shelves and check them out at a self-service point. Your student card functions as a library card.

You can also use CataloguePlus to request materials from the repository, which will be sent to a library location of your choice. You will receive an email as soon as the materials are available for you to collect.

Most books can be borrowed for 28 days, and renewal is automatic unless the book has been requested by someone else. The maximum loan period is six months. Certain special materials can only be viewed on-site.

Secure Wi-Fi is available at all UvA locations. For security purposes, we recommend setting up your Wi-Fi connection at home.


Software for your studies
