

OUTLINE LCC FOR ART HISTORY

The Library UvA places printed acquisitions for the Humanities collection according to the *Library of Congress Classification* (LCC). The LCC-codes make up the beginning of the call numbers for books and journals that are placed in open shelving. Most literature for Art History is placed in open shelving at the University Library, Singel 425. Other libraries of the UvA, e.g. the library of the P.C. Hoofthuis, might also hold relevant publications.
